ⁱⁱ The course for the first race covered road, grass fields, and plough in the Cherwell Canal - Woodstock Road area of Oxford. In later years, the races at Oxford were staged over the Cowley and Shotover course.

ⁱⁱⁱ The Cambridge races began by the Hills Road railway bridge and went south to the Gog Magog Hills (The Gogs).

^{iv} In 1890, Oxford and Cambridge sought a neutral course for the first time. Both the Shotover and Gogs courses were regarded as 'shockingly unfair' to the visiting side. They approached Thames Hare and Hounds and the race was staged at Roehampton. However, it was a disaster with both teams going off course and being unable to get back on it. According to *The Sunday Times* of 2nd December 1990 (in the report of the Centenary Race): "But fortunately there was no repetition yesterday of the incident in 1890 when the paper trail leading the runners under a railway bridge disappeared on the other side, necessitating that year's race to be re-run." Therefore, a 'no race' was declared and it was re-run in February 1891 in Oxford and the universities did not try Thames again until 1896, since when, they have been the hosts.

^v Re-staging in Oxford of the abandoned 1890 race.

^{vi} Thames Hare and Hounds hosted the race for the first time since the ill-fated 1890 attempt and it was moved back to Roehampton. Unlike 1890, there were no problems this time, for this was the first recorded use of *Pioneers*, rather than a paper trail, to mark the course. Thames have been the hosts of the race ever since.

^{vii} In 1920, the scoring system was changed from five in a team with all scoring to six in a team with the first five scoring. Under this scoring system, the non-scorers' placings did not count in the overall match score, e.g. if a runner finished in tenth place and the sixth man (i.e. non-scorer) from the other university finished ahead of him, he scored nine points rather than ten. This system was used from 1920 to 1936.

^{viii} In 1920, there was a race between a combined Oxford and Cambridge side and Cornell University two-and-a-half weeks after the University Race. As reported in *The Annals of the Thames Hare and Hounds*, "The biggest event in public interest in season 1920-1921 was the cross-country race between the combined forces of Oxford and Cambridge, and Cornell University, on Thursday 30th December 1920. The request to hold it over the usual University course had been agreed at the Annual General Meeting in October and members were available in sufficient numbers to lay an excellent trail and to pioneer. The race attracted a lot of attention and Oxford and Cambridge won an excellent race by 20 points to 29." The last sentence should read, "...Oxford and Cambridge won an excellent race by 26 points to 29."

^{xi} 1938 was the last year that the race was held at Horton Kirby in Kent.

^{xii} This was the first race held at Roehampton for twenty years. According to the Thames Hare and Hounds Minute Book, no Blues or Half-Blues were awarded as the race was considered the last of the wartime matches and was not counted in the 'authentic series'. The race was run under an eight in a team with the first six to score format. This format was subsequently adopted in 1948.

^{xiii} This was the first 'authentic' Inter-'Varsity race since the war and the first race at Roehampton since 1925. In 1945, the scoring system reverted to the pre-1937 format of six in a team with the first five scoring. As before, the non-scorers' placings did not count in the overall match scores. This system was used in 1945, 1946 and 1947.

^{xiv} The four-way tie for first place in 1947 caused much controversy at the time. As *The Times* of Saturday 1st December 1990 reported: "Records may be irrelevant in Brasher's view but, in Elliott's [A.J.Elliott, then President of Thames Hare and Hounds], they have helped put an end to the raging argument of 1947. Oxford finished four in a line T.P.E. Curry, J.F. Pollard, G. Ridding and N.M. Green. Sandy Duncan and Harold Abrahams, two leading voices of the day, argued whether such contrivance was honourable. "Slacking-off just was not done in university cross-country running," Elliott said."

^{xv} In 1948, the scoring system was changed from six in a team with the first five to score to eight in a team with the first six to score. From 1948 to 1951, the non-scorers' placings did not count in the overall match score.

^{xvi} In 1952, the race was held in dense fog and was run over the Thames Hare and Hounds' 'fog course', which was similar in distance and route to the normal course, but in several parts in remained on defined tracks instead of open country.

^{xvii} In 1952, the scoring system was altered so that non-scorers' placings did count in the overall match score. This system has remained in place to the present day.

^{xviii} This was the first time that the 40-minute barrier for the course was broken.
